



Spa Day


Relax & Rejuvenate

We also had the pleasure of having the Butterfly Singer come and entertain us during our party. There was a lot of singing and dancing throughout the afternoon, and smiles all around.






Edinburgh Zoo

One of our activity coordinators, Alex, got married on the 17th of February and three of our lovely ladies attended the wedding.




