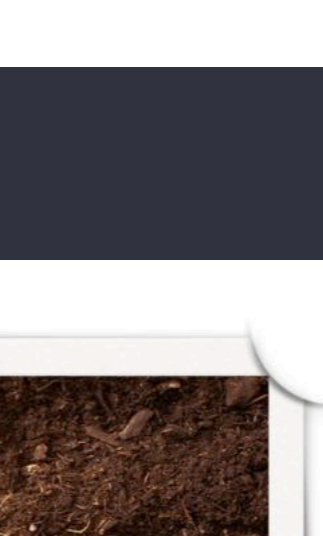

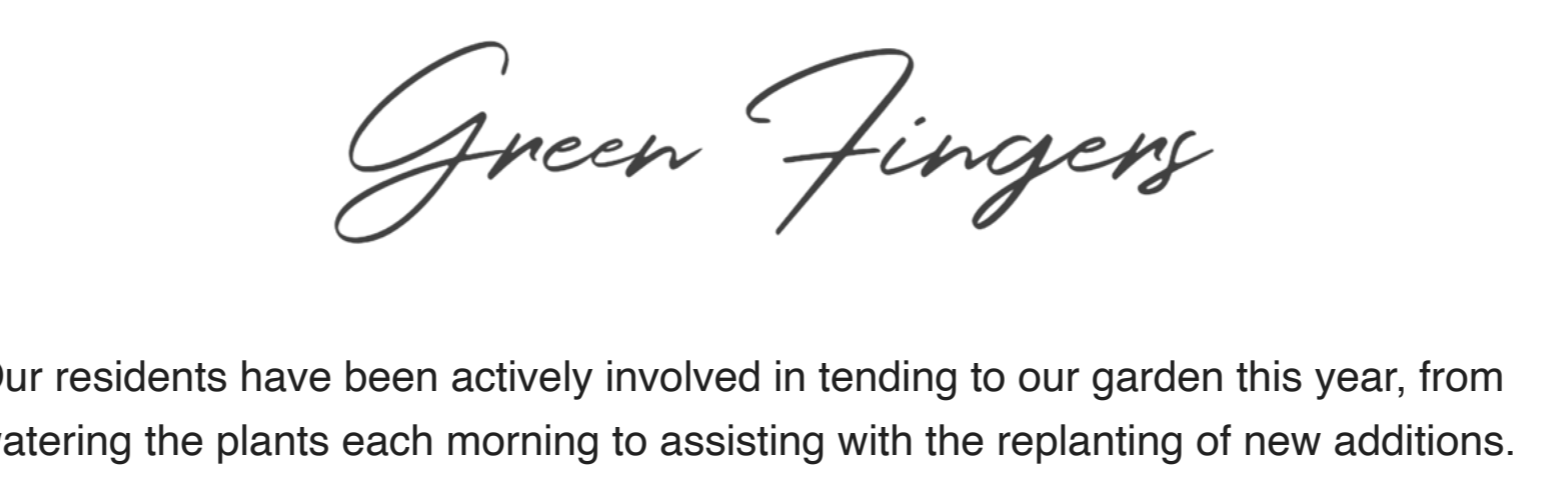

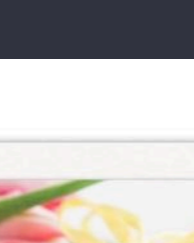


Gardening Club

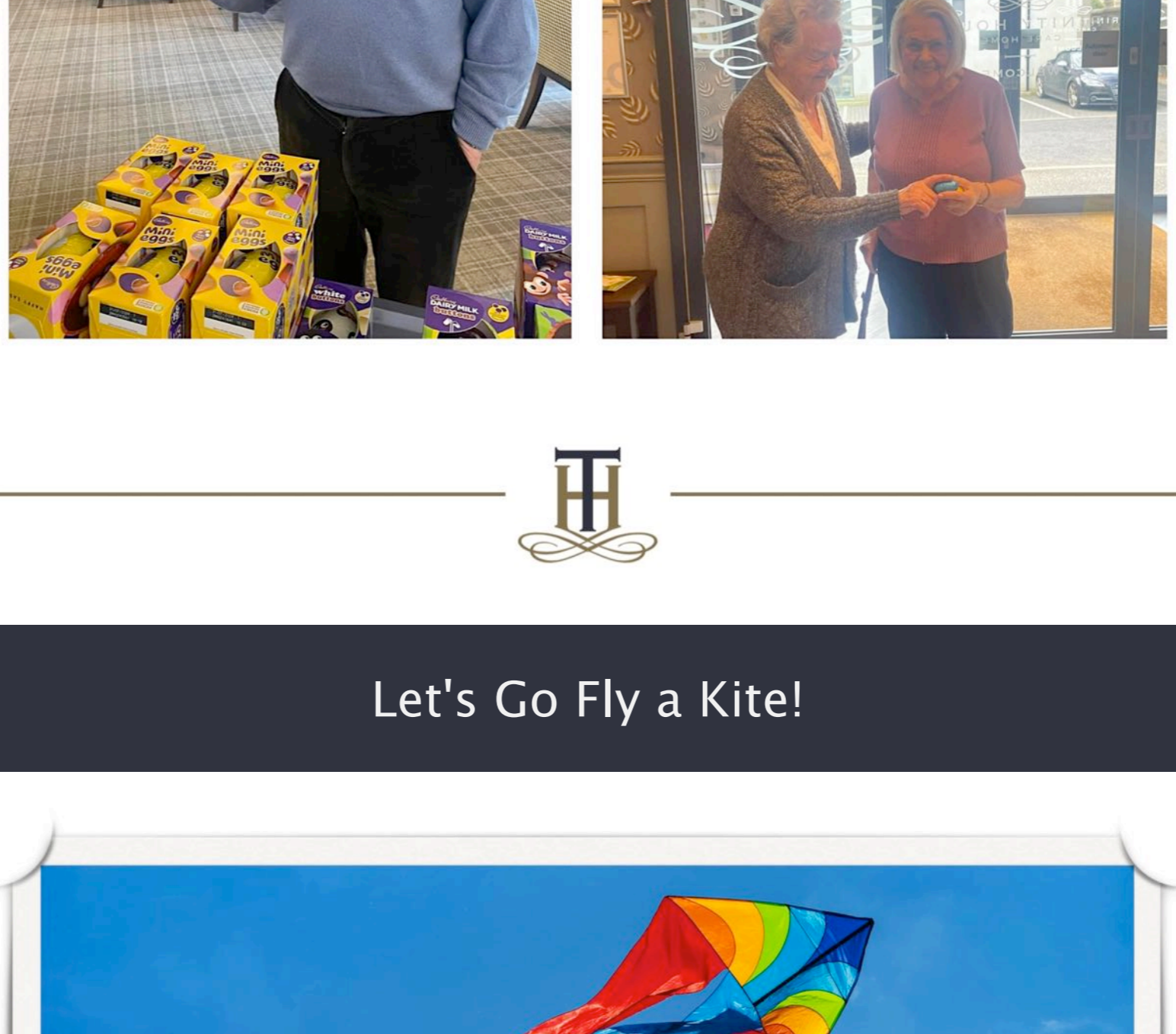

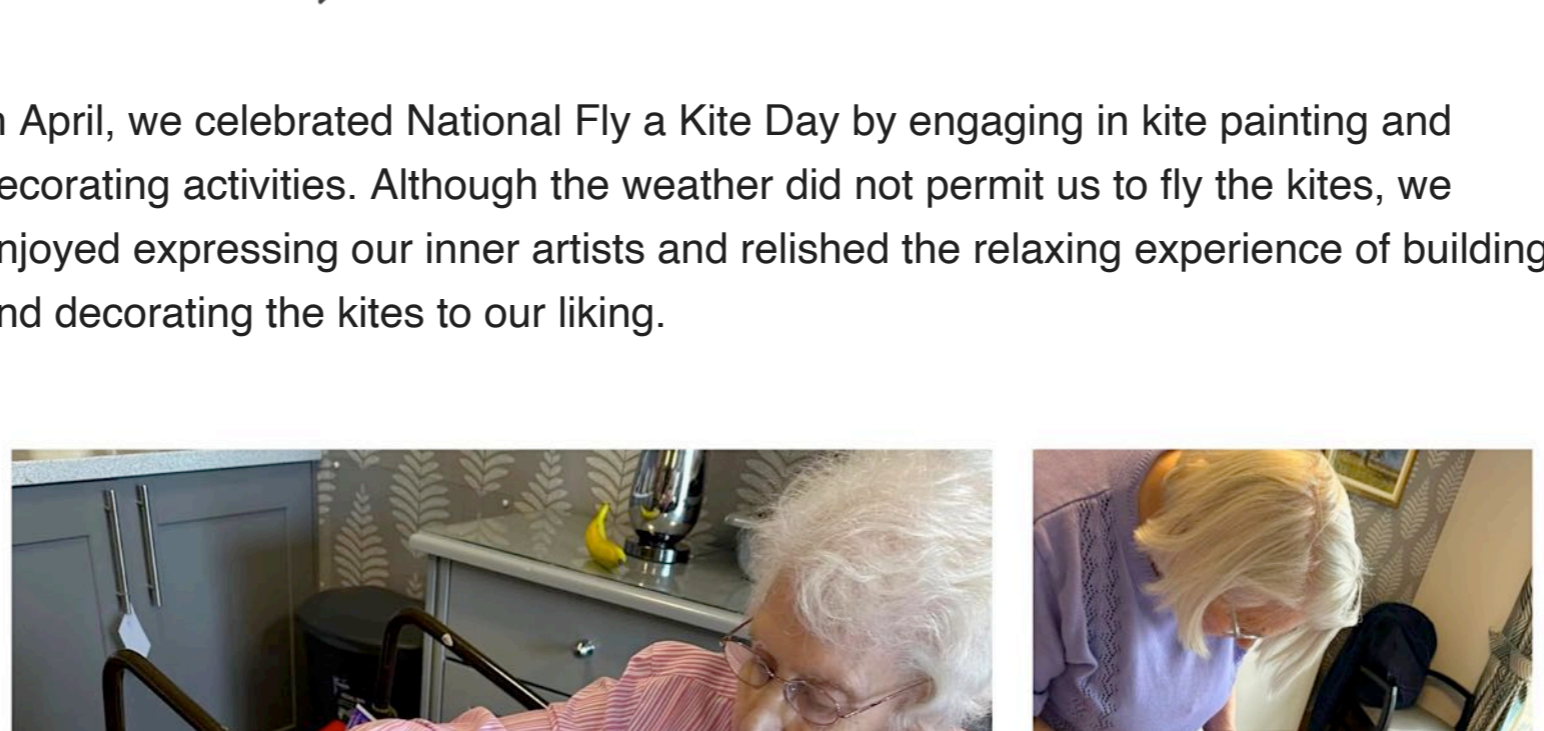


Celebrations

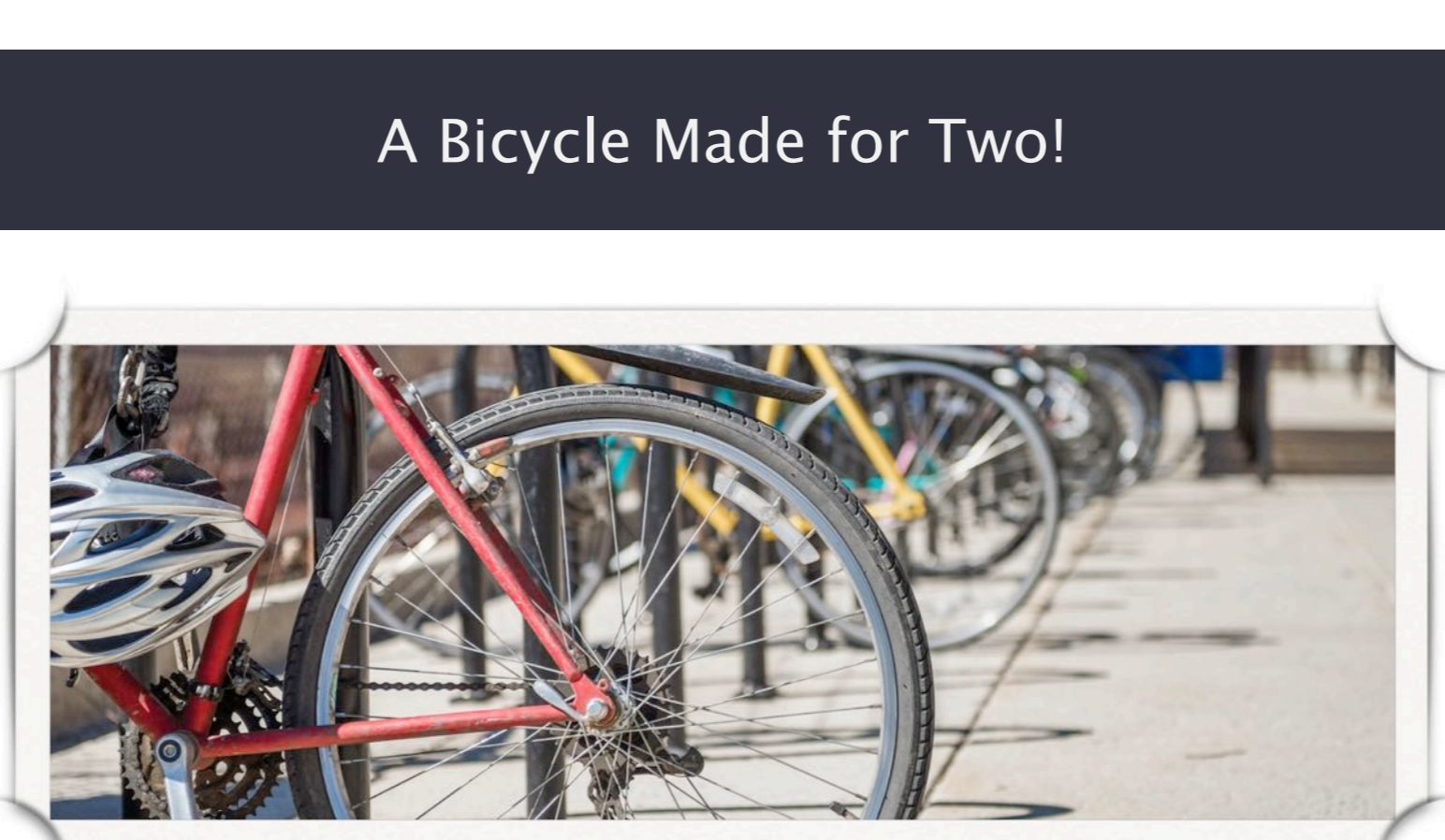


Let's Go Fly a Kite!

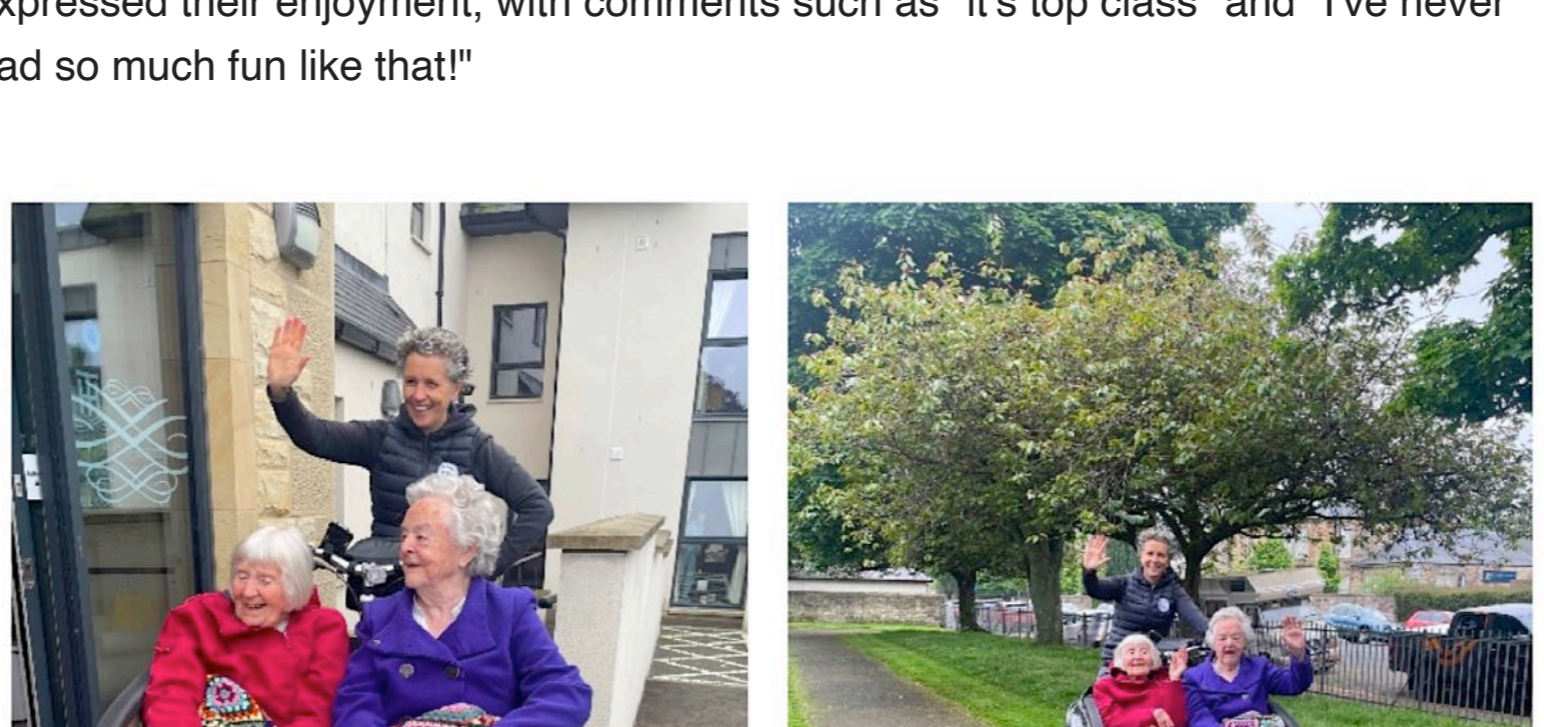


Happy Times!

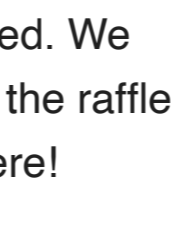


A Bicycle Made for Two!

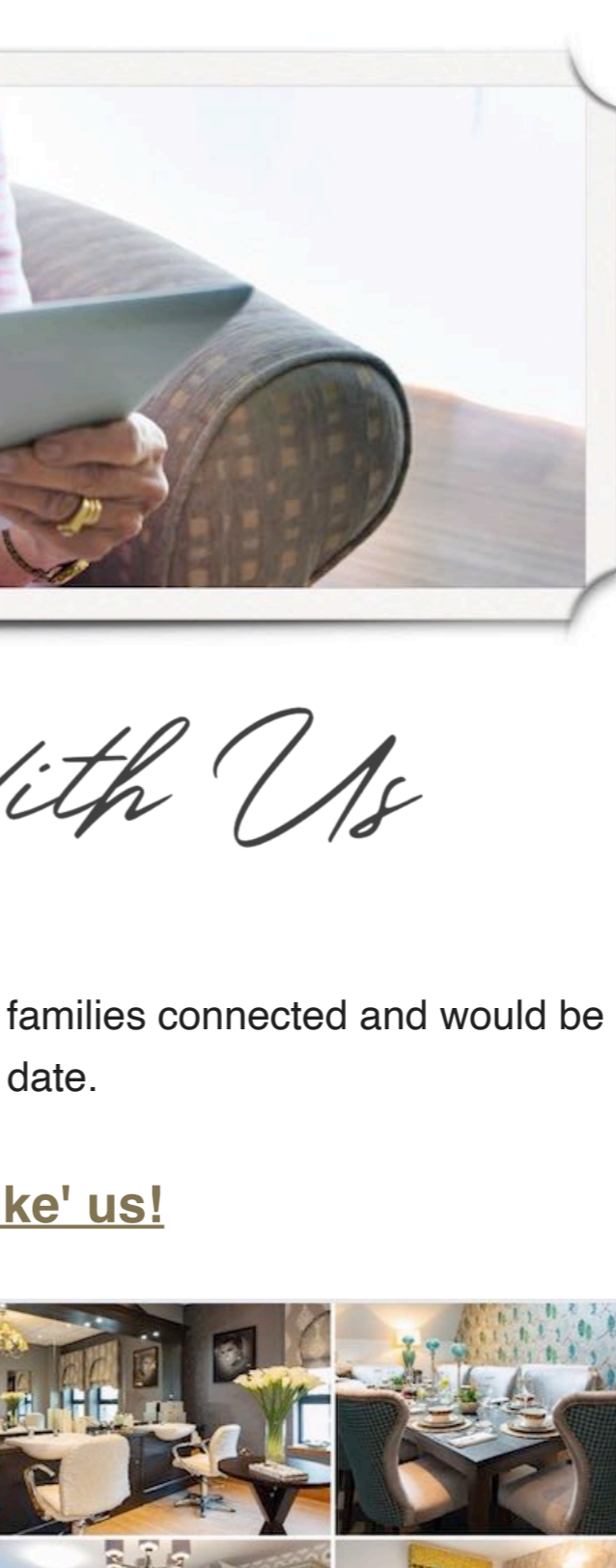
Summer Fete

Coming Up...

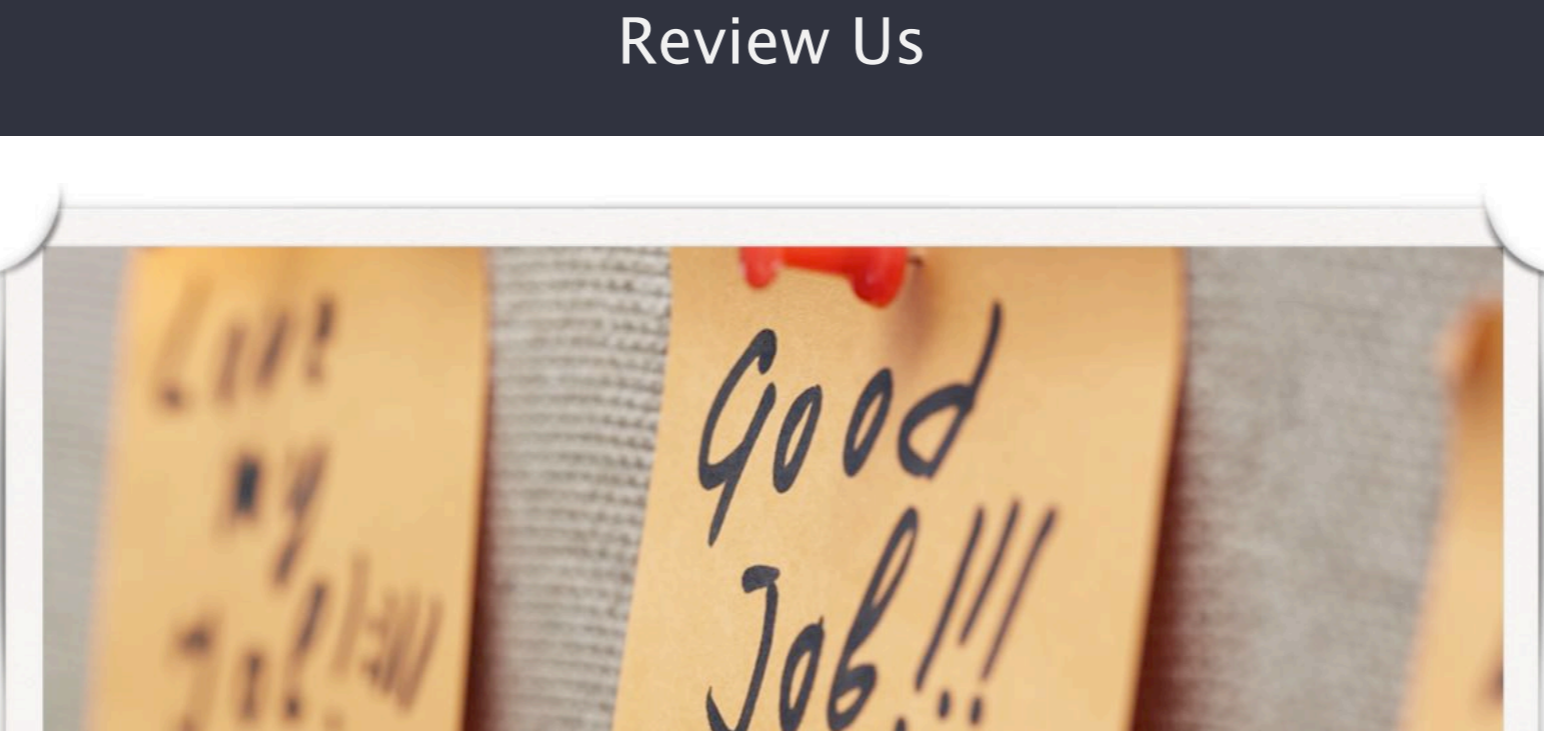
We are excited to announce our upcoming annual strawberry fete on the 27th of July.

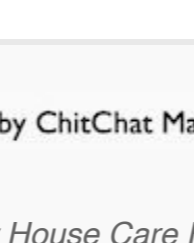
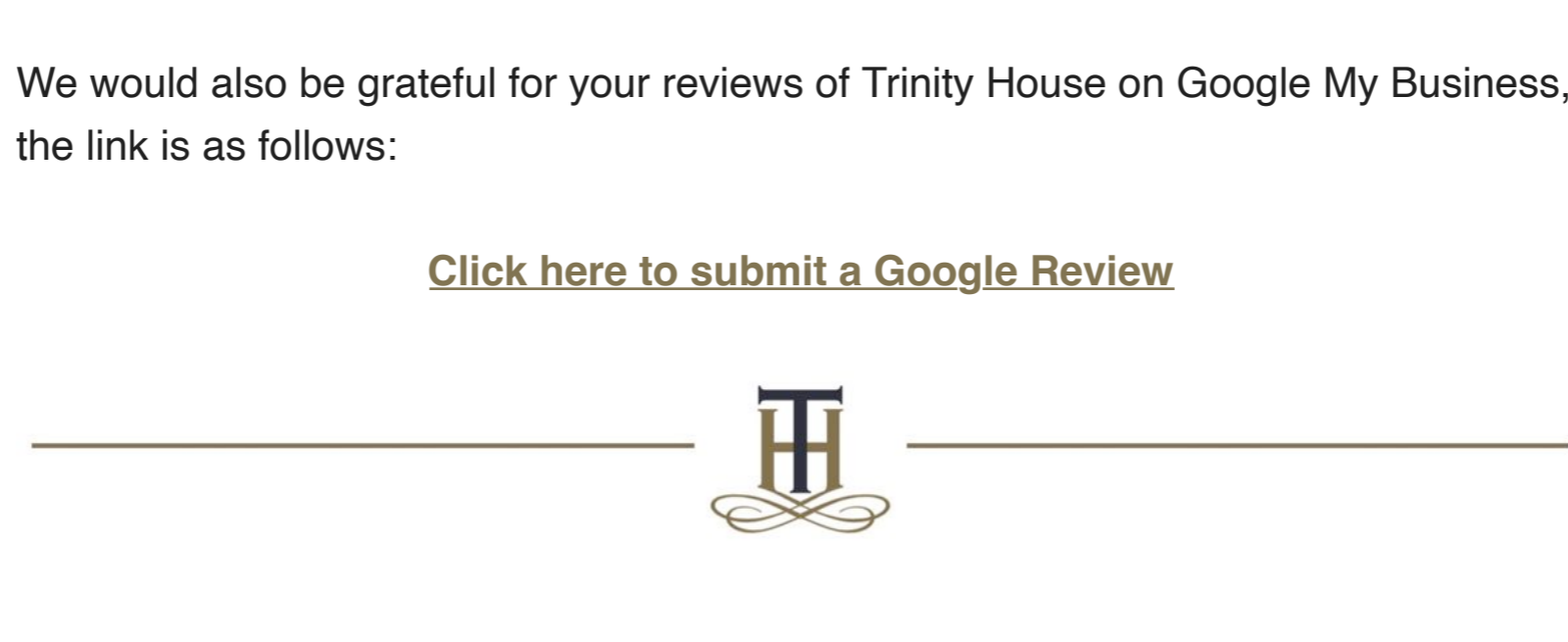

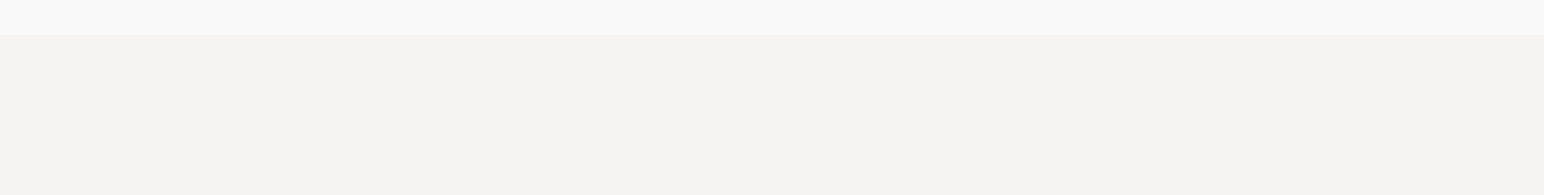
