As we settle into November and the beauty of autumn surrounds us, it's been wonderful to see our residents enjoying so many special moments together.

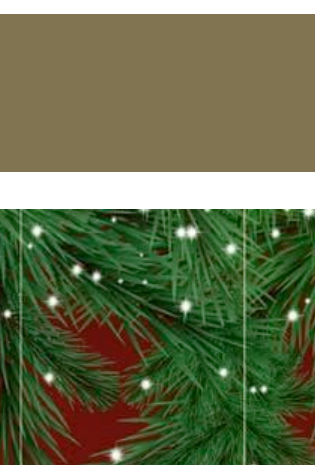

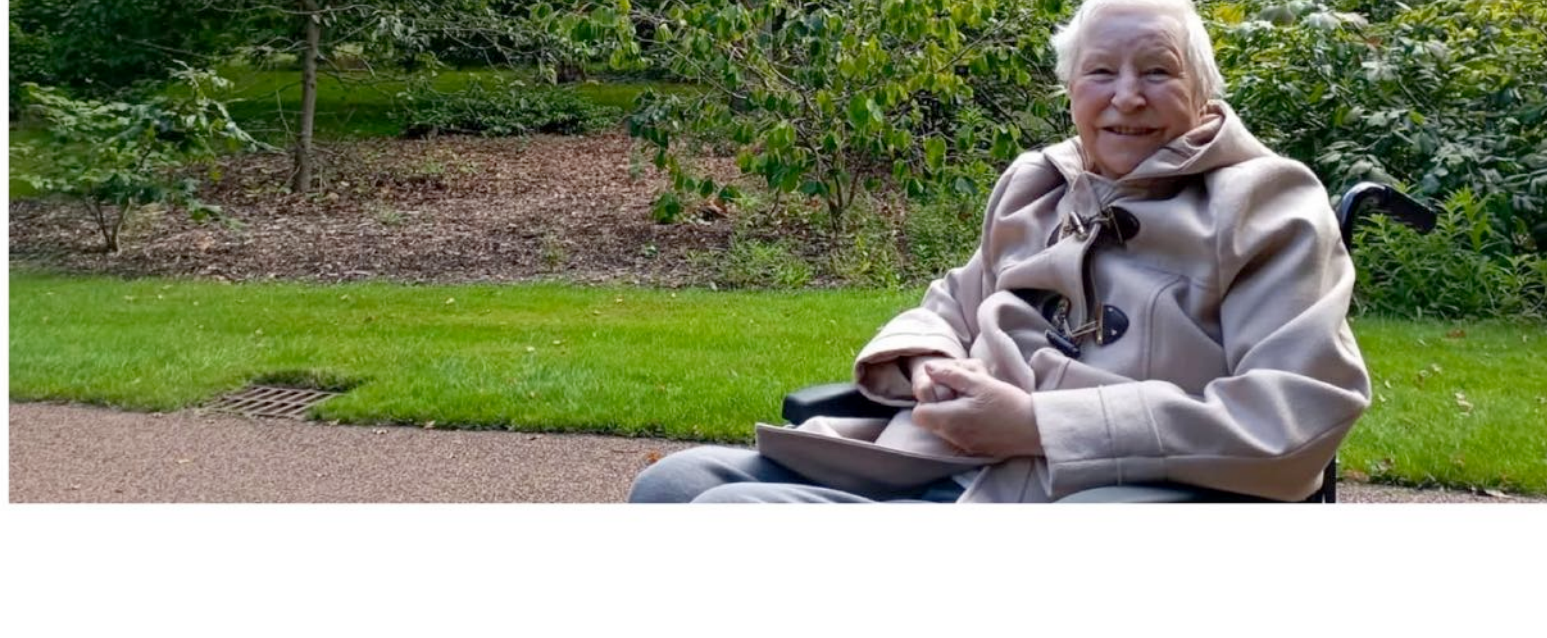

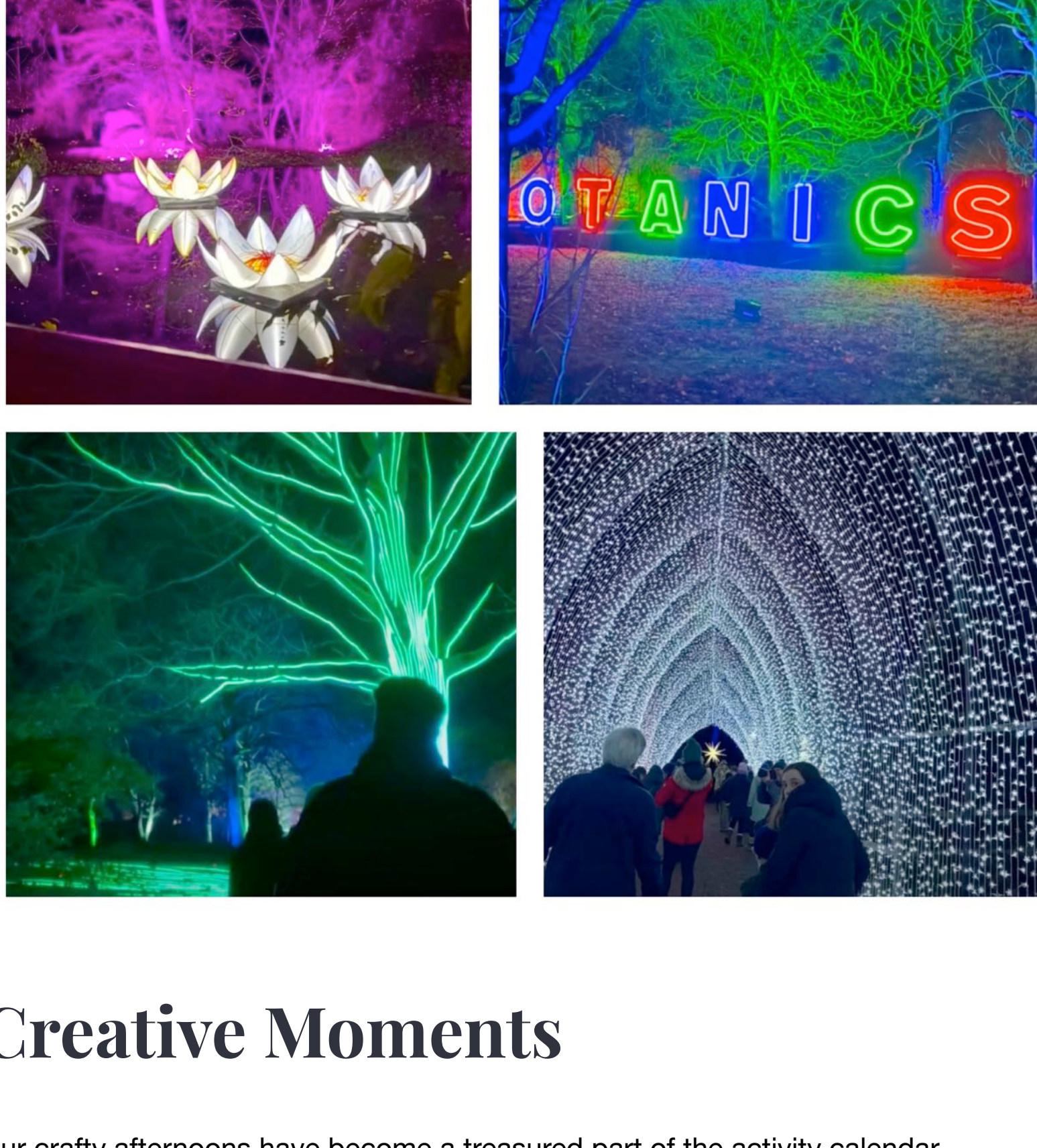

A Slice Of Fun: Pizza Making

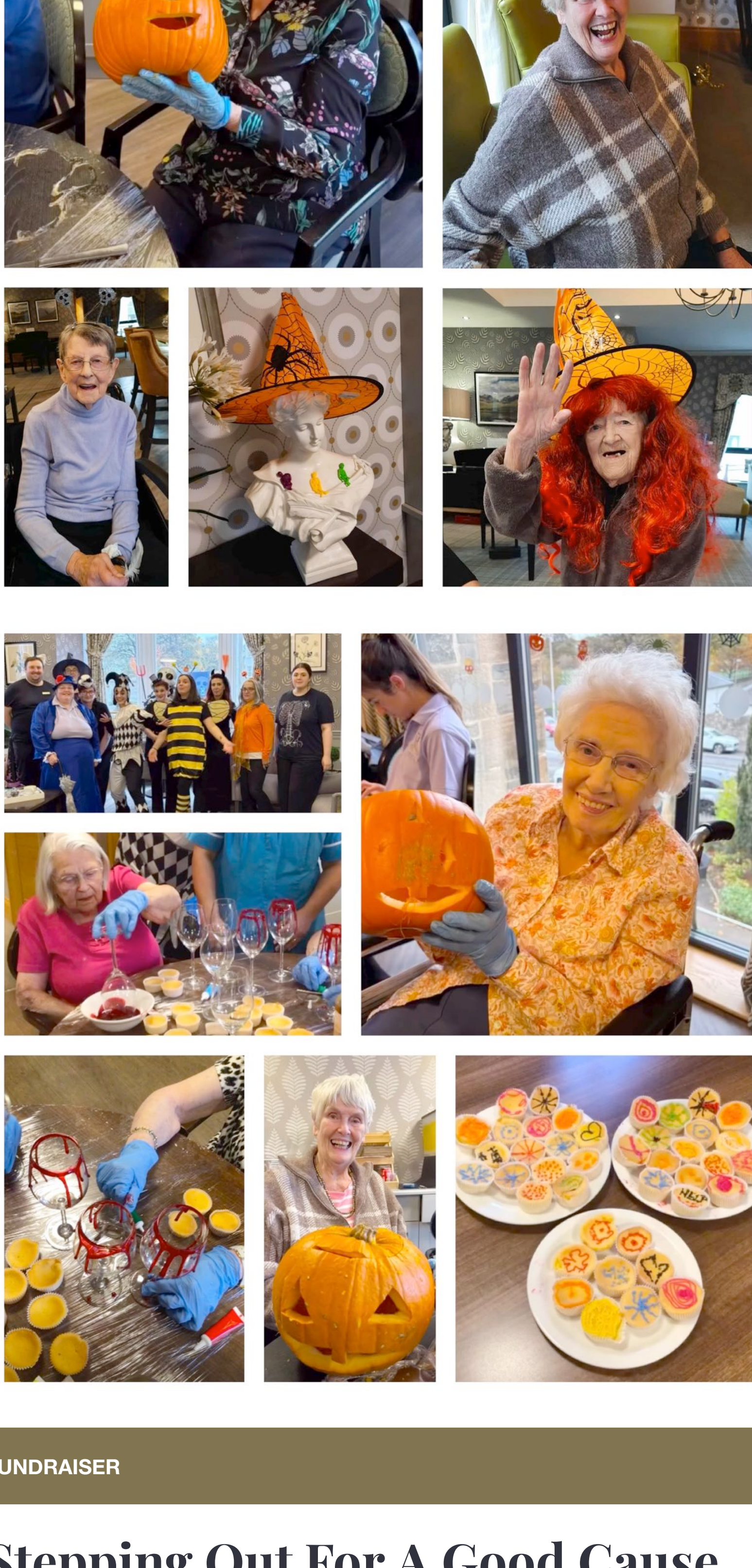

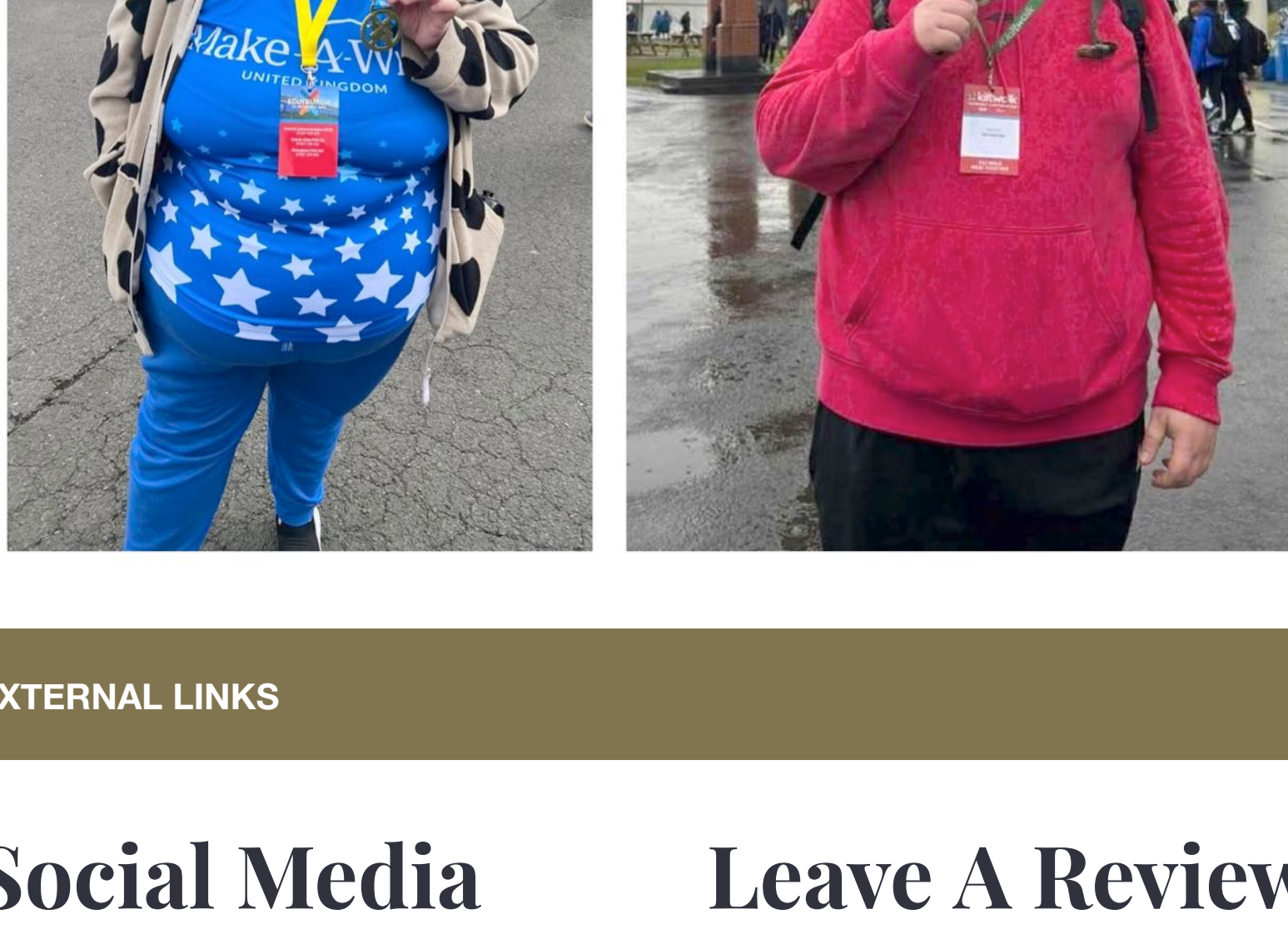


FUNDRAISER

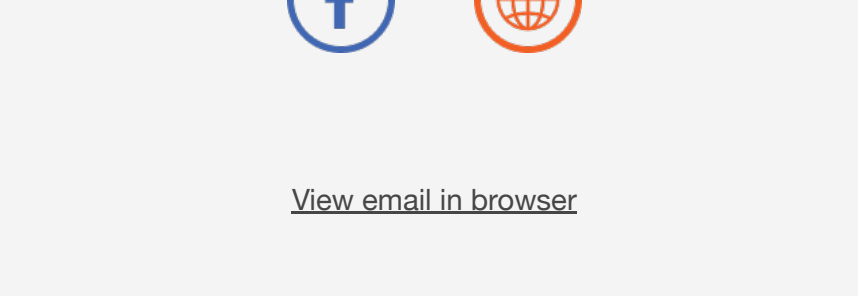

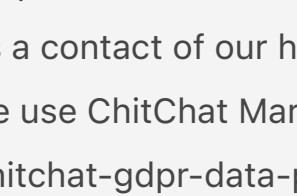
