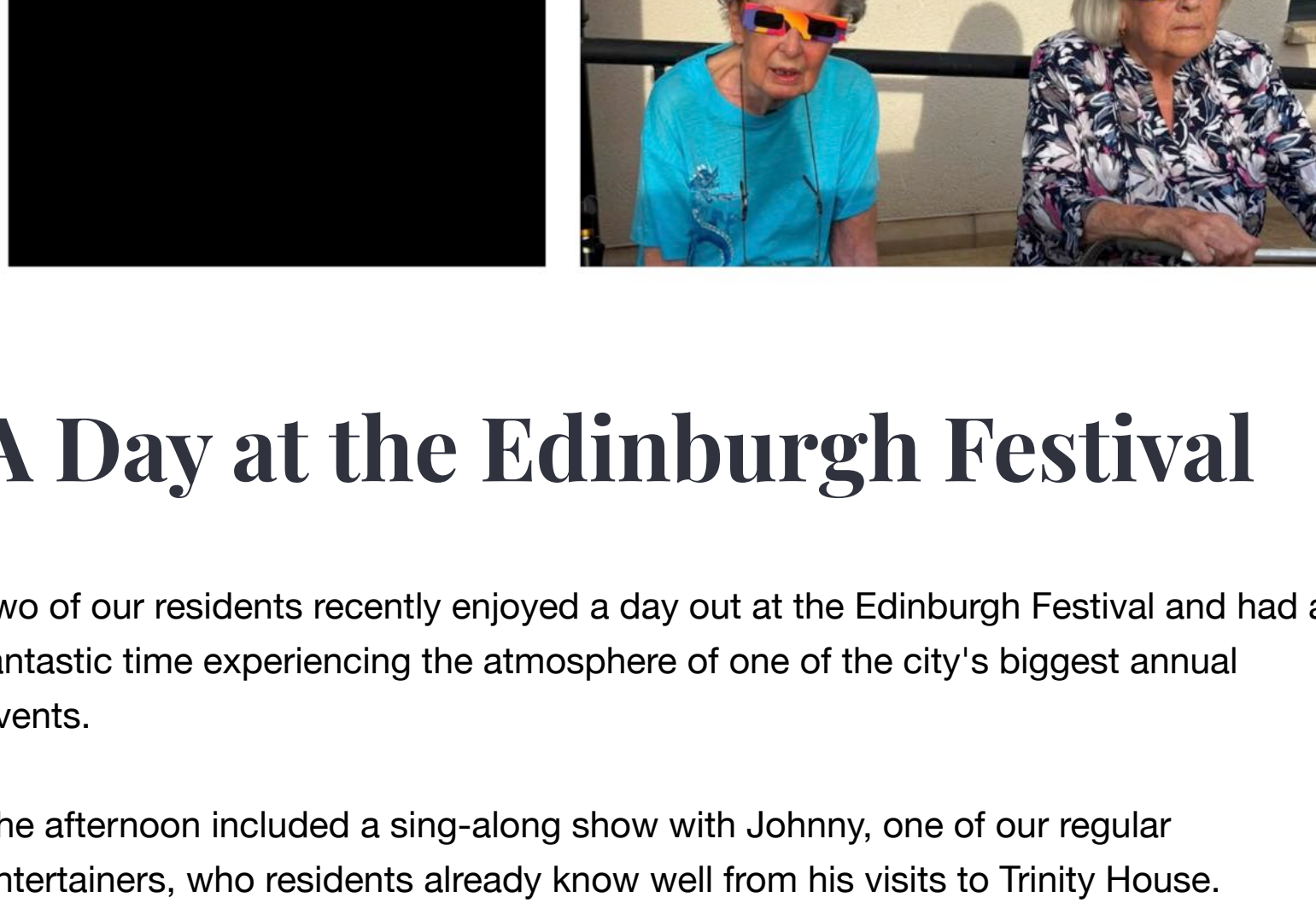
ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

Our ladies were delighted to be back enjoying a live show once again and had a lovely day out together.

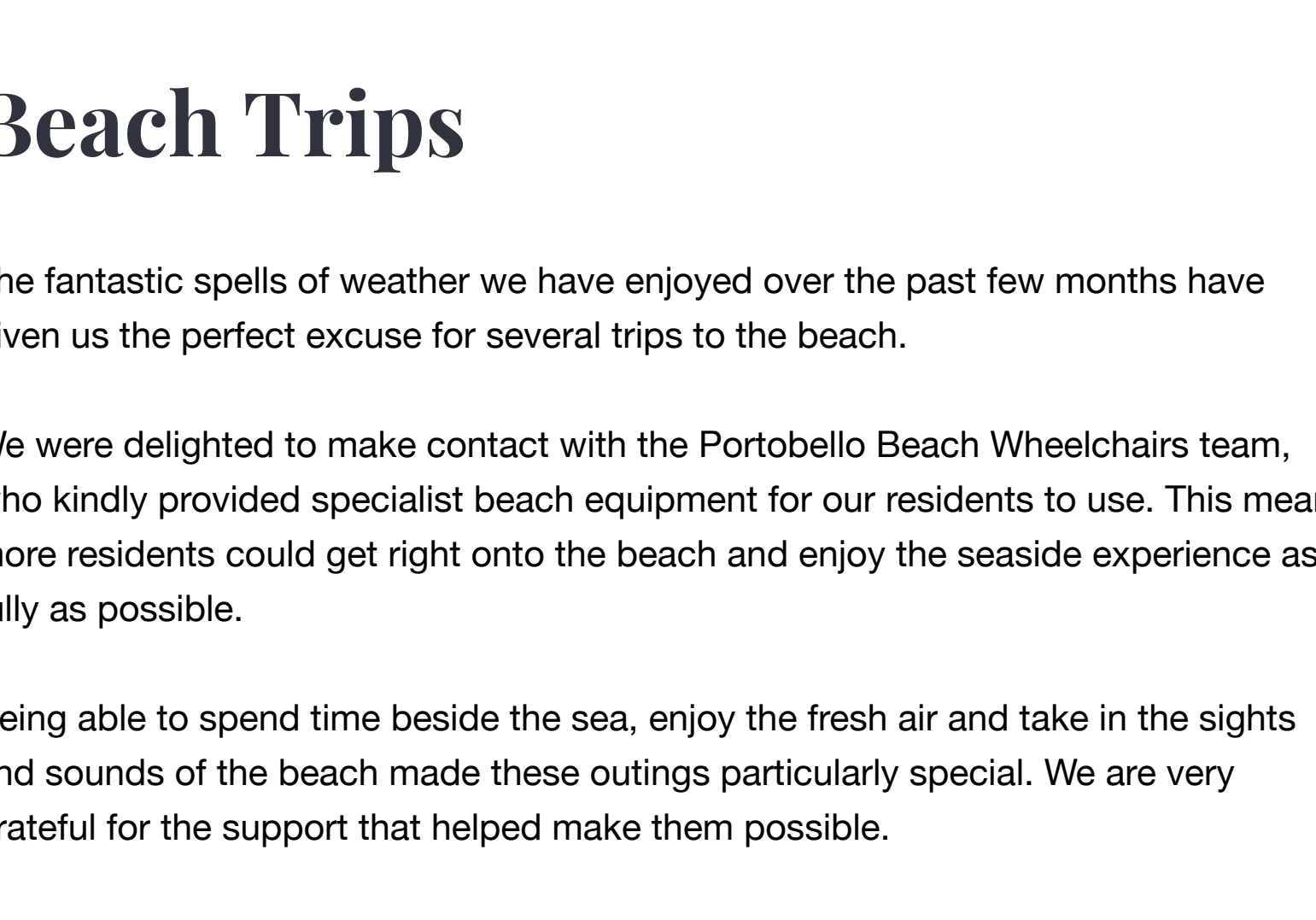
Happy Hoofbeats

These visits are always popular and bring plenty of smiles around the home.

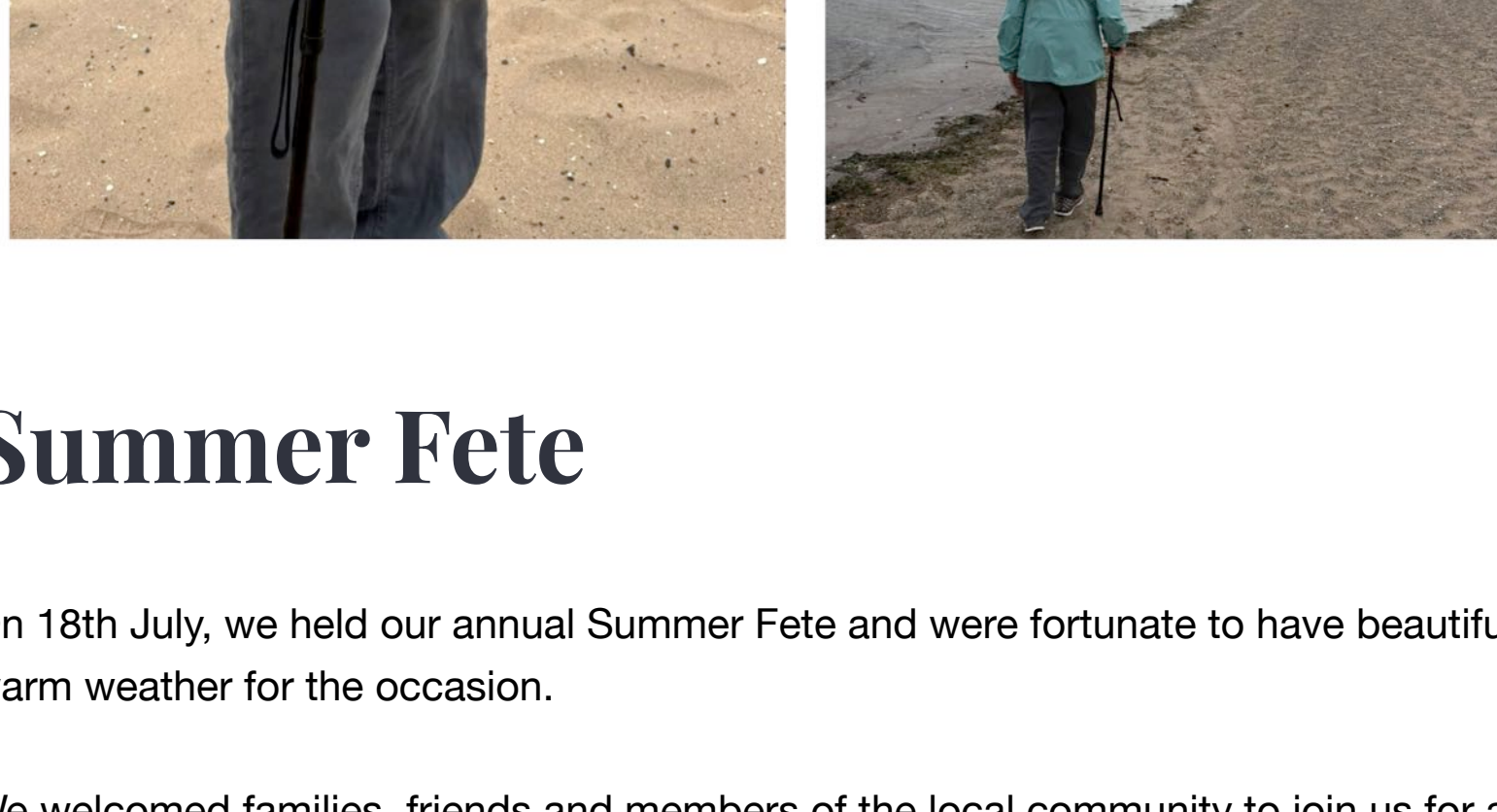


Beach Trips

These afternoons are always good fun and give residents the opportunity to discover new favourites as well as enjoy some familiar treats.

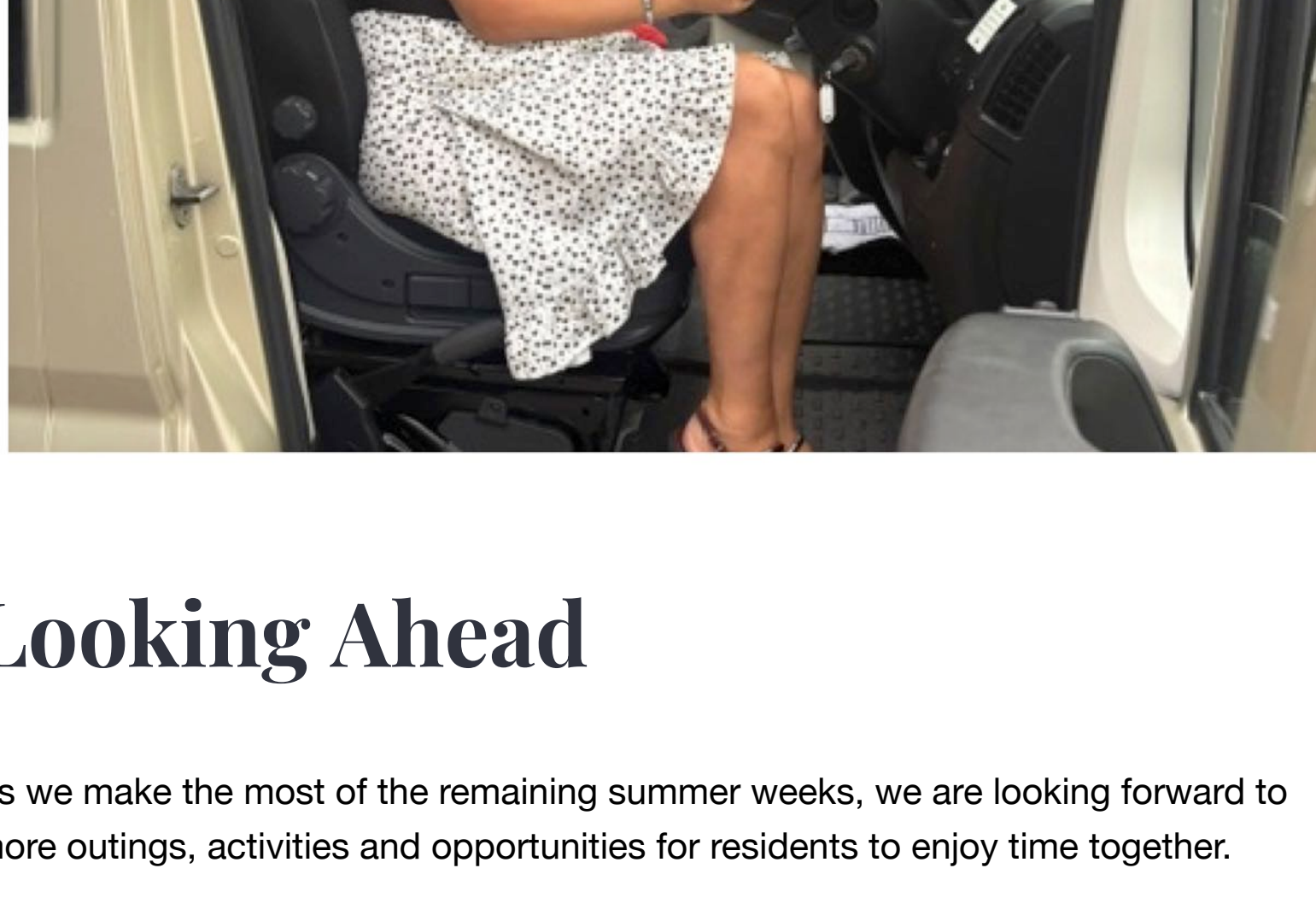


COMING UP
